

ALTON WATER RS FEVA/200 OPEN 2017 6th May 2017

Organizing Authority: Alton Water Sports Centre in conjunction with the RS Class Association UK and RS Feva Class Association UK

NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the RYA will apply.
- 1.3 International RS Class Rules will apply.
- 1.4 Competitors shall sail in accordance with the Royal Yachting Association (RYA) Racing Charter.
- 1.5 Other than the matters included in this notice of race, no racing rule changes requiring advance preparation will apply. Racing rule changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The event is open to all boats of the RS Feva and RS 200 Class Associations.
- 2.2 Competitors must be a current member of the RS Feva Class Association or RS Class Associations. Evidence of membership may be required at registration.
- 2.3 The maximum number of entries for the series (aggregate of all fleets) is 60 boats. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis.
- 2.4 Competitors shall fully complete **on-line pre-entry** at <u>http://www.altonwater.co.uk/index.php?pid=243</u> and make the appropriate payment.
- 2.5 In addition to on-line pre-entry, competitors shall fully complete and sign an Entry Form, see **Appendix 1**, and bring it with them to registration. In the case of competitors aged less than 18 years of age, the Entry Form shall be signed by their parent/guardian/supervising adult. **No signed Entry Form, no entry.**
- 2.6 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2 million for any one incident and shall sign a declaration to that effect before going afloat, (see **APPENDIX 1 ENTRY FORM**).

3.0 ENTRY FEES

- 3.1 No entry fees are refundable for this event.
- 3.2 The entry fee for this event will be **£10** for AWSC members and **£15** for non-members.

4.0 PROGRAMME AND SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1 The event will consist of a 4 race series.
- 4.2 **Saturday 6th May** Registration will be open from 09.30am until 10.30am. Race briefing will take place at 10:30am and the first warning signal no earlier than 11.30am.

4.3 At the discretion of the Race Officer, two races sailed back-to-back will be sailed before a short break for lunch, followed by two races sailed back-to-back after lunch. Further details will be given during the race briefing.

5.0 MEASUREMENT

5.1 All boats and equipment shall conform to their class association rules.

6.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Sailing instructions will be displayed on the official notice board and will be available to download in advance from the AWSC website. Individual copies will not be handed out at registration, so please print off a copy.

7.0 COURSES AND RACING AREA

- 7.1 Racing will take place on Alton Water Reservoir within the limits prescribed in the sailing instructions.
- 7.2 Courses will be laid using the fixed and portable marks as deemed appropriate by the OOD.
- 7.3 Starting and finishing will generally be from a committee boat.
- 7.4 The race course, which will depend on the prevailing weather conditions, will be set on the day and will be described to competitors during the race briefing. It is proposed to use a trapezoid course.

8.0 RULES DISPUTES, PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

8.1 The Exoneration Penalty (and Advisory Hearing and RYA Arbitration) of the RYA Rules Dispute Procedures will be available.

9.0 SCORING

- 9.1 One race will be sufficient to constitute a series.
- 9.2 The low points system of scoring will be applied.
- 9.3 The number of races to be discarded will be as follows:
 - 4 or more races sailed 1 discard

10.0 SUPPORT BOATS

- 10.1 All support boats will adhere to the RS Class Association UK safety Policy as published on the RS Class Association UK website
- 10.2 All support boats shall comply with local and event regulations.
- 10.3 Each support boat shall carry a radio and should also carry a mobile phone, call sign and telephone number to be advised to the event Safety Officer.
- 10.4 The radio channel used on the racing area will be advised at the competitors briefing.
- 10.5 Kill cords shall be worn whilst engines are running, the course safety officer will be looking out for compliance on this issue, there are no excuses and boats may be requested to leave the race area immediately if kill cords are not being used appropriately.
- 10.6 The official event photographer may move between the starting line and course marks in order to photograph the event, this boat will display a distinguishing flag.

11.0 BERTHING

11.1 Limited storage of competitor's boats is available free of charge for the duration of the event. However, whilst AWSC will attempt to store all competitors' boats, this cannot be guaranteed.

12.0 PRIZES

12.1 Subject to sufficient entries in each fleet and at the discretion of the Race Committee, prizes will be awarded for first, second and third placed boats in the RS Feva, 200 and 400 fleets.

13.0 RISK STATEMENT

13.1 Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone".

Sailing is by its nature is an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves elements of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;

14.0 INSPECTIONS

14.1 The fact that the race committee conducts inspections of a boat does not reduce the responsibilities of each competitor set out in this Notice of Race.

15.0 RIGHTS TO NAMES AND LIKENESSES

15.1 Competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority, without payment, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures, taped, or filmed television of or relating to the event.

16.0 RADIO COMMUNICATION

16.1 A boat shall neither make nor receive radio communications while racing. This restriction includes the use of mobile telephones.

17.0 INSURANCE

17.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 for any one incident and shall sign a declaration to that effect before going afloat (see **APPENDIX 1 ENTRY FORM**).
