### RS200 Open Meeting

#### Notice of Race to be held on

**17<sup>th</sup> October 2020**

#### 1. Rules

- The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing

#### 2. Advertising

- Advertising shall comply with ISAF regulation 20 and the relevant rules of the Class Association

#### 3. Eligibility and entry

- The regatta is open to all boats of the RS200 Class
- Eligible boats up to a limit of 20 can enter by completing the attached entry form and emailing it to [roger.boyle5@btinternet.com](mailto:roger.boyle5@btinternet.com)
- Boats will be entered on a first come first served basis

#### 4. Entry fees

- The entry fee will be £15 per boat payable by cheque or cash to St Mawes Sailing Club

#### 5. Schedule

- There will be no formal registration
- Briefing will be by email

#### 6. Sailing instructions

- The sailing instructions will be emailed to all competitors prior to the event

#### 7. Courses

- The course will be a standard windward leeward course as outlined in the sailing instructions
- All racing will take place within the Carrick Roads area opposite Falmouth Harbour

#### 8 Scoring

- 1 race will constitute series

- When four races are completed, one discard will be allowed

#### **9. Radio communication**

- No radio communication will be permitted

#### **10 Prizes**

- No prizes will be awarded as current Covid restrictions will prevent the holding of a prize-giving ceremony

#### **11 Risk Statement**

- Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for the boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone"
- By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
  - They are aware of the inherent risks of sailing
  - They are responsible for the safety of themselves and crew while afloat
  - They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss caused by their own actions or omissions
  - Their boat is in good order and they are fit to participate
  - The provision of a race management team, safety boats and other volunteers does not relieve them of their own responsibilities

#### **12. Special precautions**

- Due to the current pandemic, crews may be asked to launch from different locations to comply with regulations
- Crews will be notified in advance and will be collected by a local rib before being led to the racing area
- No catering or changing facilities will be available

#### **12 Insurance**

- Each participating boat shall be insured with third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000.
