We are very much looking forward to welcoming you all to SCYC, Abersoch!

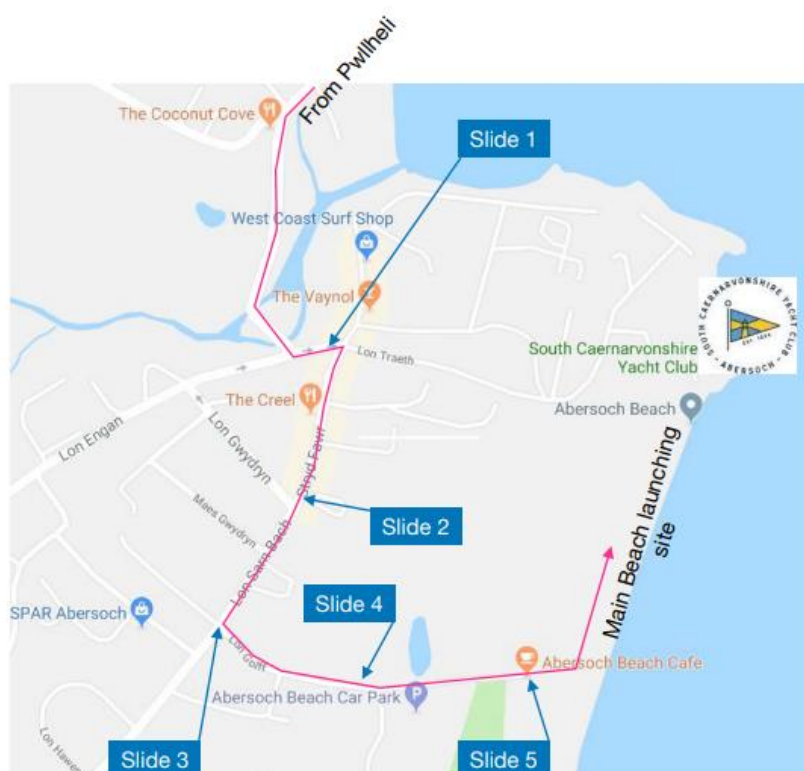
Please read these Joining Instructions to help you before you leave home, on arrival and during the week. We hope you have a great week of sailing, socialising and enjoying everything South Caernarvonshire Yacht Club and the surrounding area have to offer. Debbie Jarvis will be your Class Secretary and should be able to help you with any queries.

#### **PRIOR TO LEAVING HOME, PLEASE:**

- **Make sure you have ordered your food tickets by 27<sup>th</sup> July 2025** (we cannot guarantee tickets will be available on site).
  - o Monday Masters Meal, Wednesday Party Night Curry and Friday Championship BBQ & Party. Book [here](#).
  - o You can also order a specially commissioned, limited edition print [here](#), all profits go to the RNLI.
- Plan and pack your fancy dress for the Music Icons Party and your Black Tie, Party Dress or other smart dress for the Championship Dinner BBQ & Party.
- If you haven't already, let us know if you have any specific dietary requirements by emailing [membership@rs-association.com](mailto:membership@rs-association.com), even if you have not ordered any meals, as SCYC will be serving complimentary treats.
- If you have any medical issues that responders should be aware of in an emergency, please bring a sealed envelope with details to registration. If awareness needs to be raised other than in an emergency, please leave the envelope unsealed.
- Make sure all the details on your entry are correct, that both helm and crew are RS Class Association members and that your sail number matches your boat number. If there are any changes, please email [membership@rs-association.com](mailto:membership@rs-association.com).
- Join the **Event WhatsApp Group** via [this link](#), please note that on joining the group, your phone number and any profile photo will be visible to other group members. The group will be used for communication with competitors, but will not replace the Official Noticeboard at SCYC outside the office on the middle deck.

## DIRECTIONS AND ARRIVAL

Proceed down the A499 from Pwllheli into Abersoch Village centre.



Following slides 1-6 on this [Arrival Guide](#) will take you to exactly where you need to be; the beach. Check the tide, as the gate onto the beach will be closed one hour before and one hour after high tide. You can't get onto the beach during this period.

Gwynedd Council's Beach Control may ask you to walk your trailer onto the far end of the beach – to the left as per slide 6 of the guide. They may let you drive on the beach, they may not. If they do, please drive slowly and courteously and thank them. If they do not let you drive, then please respect this decision; arguing will get you nowhere.

You can either leave your trailer on the beach or take it home – the decision is totally up to you.

## CAR PARKING

From the beach and the village, you can drive up Lon Traeth (Beach Road) – see the big red cross on slide 2. This is where the car parks are (but as it says on slide 2, this is not the launching area). There are two car parks near SCYC, neither belong to SCYC. From this year, the car parks are managed by Parking Eye. Please read the instructions carefully for how long you can stay and how much to pay; a weekly ticket via the app is probably the best option.

## CLUBHOUSE

Once you have put your boat on the beach you can walk into the village and to SCYC. From the village, you can walk up Lon Traeth (Beach Road) – see the big red cross on slide 2.

## **REGISTRATION**

All competitors are required to register. Registration will be in the SCYC Clubhouse on Sunday from 15:00-18:00 and on Monday from 09:00-10:30. Registration is in the Commodore's Bar.

## **CATERING**

Breakfast rolls, hot drinks and snacks will be available every day from 09:00 until after you have gone afloat.

There will be a pizza van on site on Sunday – look out for the QR code on site and in the WhatsApp group to place orders on the day.

Wednesday Curry and Friday BBQ will be served as per the timetable below, for those who have pre-ordered.
